Intravenous fluid therapy is recommended, as it helps to support blood pressure, as well as increasing elimination of the anaesthetic drugs, resulting in a smoother, more rapid recovery for your pet. \$ 65

Standard pain relief injections will be administered prior to sending your pet home. In our experience, this is usually sufficient to keep most pets comfortable. However, as every pet is different, some may require extra pain relief medications to take home. Approx \$ 30, weight dependent

It is important to prevent your pet from chewing, licking or damaging any surgical wound. Repeat surgery is sometimes required if wound trauma occurs. An Elizabethan Collar is highly recommended to help prevent this from occurring. Approx \$ 10-25, size dependent.

Microchipping of BOTH Dogs & Cats is now required by Law in WA, if your Pet does not have a Microchip already, we can insert one today while your Pet is under anaesthetic \$ 63
